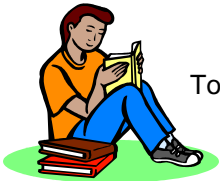


Welcome to all students and best wishes for every success in your studies.

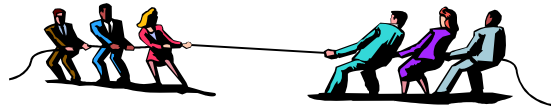

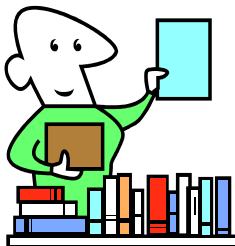
LIBRARY 101
